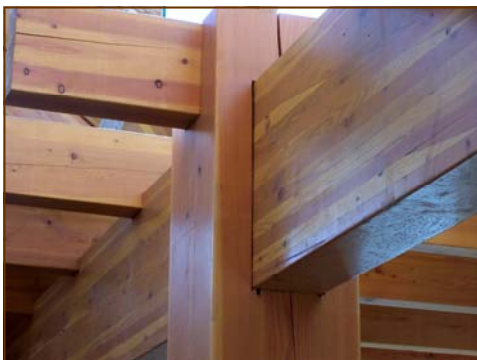

## TIMBER !

When the design for a spectacular project using open post, beam & rafter construction was conceived, the owner and builder went looking for a supplier who could locate the products and handle the associated logistics for the project. Several dealers across the Province declined to Quote. He didn't need to look any further than Davidson Enman Lumber, as we have been involved in projects of this kind on many occasions over the past 59 years. In this case, the specifications called for all Douglass Fir timbers of Number 1 Grade, smooth four sides, in various



dimensions ranging from; 12"x12" and 14"x14" - 20' posts, 8"x8" -20' beams as well as; 2"x12" - 26' and 5"x10" - 22' rafters. In addition to the structural framing timbers and lumber, we also sourced over 30,000 FBM of Douglas Fir, Glued & Laminated, S4S timbers, ranging in sizes from; 8 1/2" x 27" - 44' to as small



as 2" x 6" - 26'. To compliment the architectural finish, we also supplied both 2x6, and 1x6, S4S, Select D.Fir, Tongue & Groove Decking for the interior ceiling applications. We'll just let these pictures do the talking; you know we can do the walk.
